BRETT DRIVER

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Brett Driver is responsible for driving the house bot during matches to unstick competing bots as needed and capture unique camera angles. The Brett Driver role requires an individual with previous combat robotics experience, knowledge of NHRL rules, and able to work collaboratively with others.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Work with the referee to unstick or remove bots that are entangled, disabled, or stuck
- Act as a robotic camera operator with the house bot's onboard camera
- Drive to stay out of the way of ongoing fights
- Move damaged/destroyed bots back to the door at the conclusion of a fight
- Maintain the house bot(s) through regular maintenance such as swapping batteries, checking for damage, etc.

BRETT EXPERIENCE ATTENDANT

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Brett Experience Attendant is responsible for managing our "Brett Experience" located in the spectator lounge. The Brett Experience Attendant role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, possesses familiarity with combat robotics, and can communicate well.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Inform guests about what Brett is and how house bots operate
- Teach guests how to operate house bot within cage
- Answer questions guests may have about combat robotics
- Keep Brett Experience area clean and free of debris
- Maintain the house bot(s) through regular maintenance such as swapping batteries, checking for damage, etc.

CAGE MANAGER

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Cage Manager is responsible for maintaining cages and ensuring they are always fight ready. The Cage Manager role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, able to communicate effectively in a fast-paced environment and can solve a variety of issues in a timely manner.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Ensure that your cage is cleaned after each fight
- Repair damage to cage floors between fights
- Monitor and maintain proper operation of cage equipment (i.e., check camera alignments, ensure button boxes function, verify screens are working, etc.)
- Work with the green room to escort ready fights to your cage
- Walk competitors through the startup process of powering on and moving their bots to their respective corners, to prepare for fights
- Unload competitors after the completion of a fight
- Assist in fighting at-cage fires as needed

*****The use of PPE when inside a cage is now mandated for all NHRL staff. You will be issued a full-face P100 respirator upon arrival to NHRL, that you must put on before entering a cage.***

FACILITIES WATCH

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Facilities Watch is responsible for monitoring the status of all facility related operational elements during event days. The Facilities Watch role requires an outgoing individual who maintains a positive attitude and possesses keen attention to detail.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Assist with setup and teardown of event day operations
- Monitor all areas of facility during event day for cleanliness
- Ensure all trash receptacles are checked and emptied as required
- Refill consumables for spectators, competitors and staff as needed
- Answer spectator questions about combat robotics or event related items
- Aid other NHRL event staff in various departments as required

FRONT DESK REPRESENTATIVE

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Front Desk Representative is responsible for greeting and checking in guests as they enter the facility on event days. The NHRL Front Desk Representative role requires an outgoing individual who maintains a positive attitude and likes to have a good time!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Process all guest's check-ins by confirming ticket purchases, acting as point of sale for on-site ticket purchasing, and issuing credentials
- Act always in a courteous, safe, and efficient manner, ensuring that a high level of service is maintained
- Maintain a clean front desk area
- Distribute programs and information as required
- Be a friendly face to all guests
- Serve as a resource for guests and answer any questions as they may have

GREEN ROOM ATTENDANT

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Green Room Attendant is responsible for managing the operation of our Green Room and ensuring that competitors are present and ready to fight. The Green Room Attendant role requires an individual with an outgoing personality and can communicate clearly and effectively.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Check In bots as they arrive to the Green Room
- Monitor upcoming fights in the Green Room so production is not delayed
- Track down missing or late bots from the pits
- Disqualify extremely late bots
- Address any issues competitors have prior to fights
- Maintain a clean, comfortable green room for competitors

GUEST SERVICES AMBASSADOR

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Guest Services Ambassador is responsible for welcoming all guests into the arena on event days and acting as a general resource for guest needs. The Guest Services Ambassador role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, enjoys helping people, and likes to have a good time!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Ensure all guests feel welcome attending NHRL events
- Direct guests to various areas in the facility such as fight cages, bleachers, VIP area, restrooms and food and beverage locations
- Resolve guest complaints or problems
- Be a friendly face to all guests
- Monitor spectator facing areas for general cleanliness
- Serve as a resource for guests and answer any questions they may have

MERCHANDISE ATTENDANT

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Merchandise Attendant is responsible for assisting spectators with purchasing items at the merchandise store and organizing items for purchase. The Merchandise Attendant role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, previous sales operations experience, and enjoys helping people!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Complete retail sales and register transactions for NHRL and competitor merchandise
- Organize, inventory and tag NHRL and competitor merchandise
- Restock merchandise as needed
- Maintain a clean merchandise area
- Be a friendly face to all guests
- Serve as a resource for guests and answer any questions as they may have

PATIO ATTENDANT

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Patio Attendant is responsible for welcoming guests and overseeing general operations of the outdoor patio area. The Patio Attendant role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, enjoys helping people, and likes to have a good time!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Ensure all guests feel welcome attending NHRL events
- Oversee general operation of outdoor patio area
- Resolve guest complaints or issues
- Be a friendly face to all guests
- Monitor outdoor patio area for general cleanliness
- Assist with breakdown of outdoor patio area at conclusion of event
- Serve as a resource for guests and answer any questions they may have

PIT WATCH

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Pit Watch is responsible for dictating upcoming fights to competitors and ensure competitors are operating safely within the Pits area. The Pit Watch role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, can communicate clearly and effectively, and be able to multi-task.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Communicate via PA system with competitors on upcoming fight schedule
- Perform regular inspections in the pits to ensure competitors are compliant with NHRL rules on battery charging, PPE, and other safety requirements.
- Assist competitors in the pits as needed with repairs
- Answer questions from competitors as needed
- Assist in fire response in the pits if needed
- Maintain pits area for general cleanliness

REFEREE

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Referee is responsible for starting moderating and ending fights and making judgement calls based on NHRL rules. The Referee role requires an individual with steadfast decision-making ability, previous combat robotics experience, and can adapt to a fast-paced work environment.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Manage all aspects of running bot fights
- Communicate with the control room to ensure proper event flow
- Make decisions based on NHRL league rules
- Serve as an unbiased representative of NHRL
- The process of loading/unloading bots will now be handled by the cage managers. Once a fight has completed, you would move on to the next fight-ready cage.

*****In order to ensure more consistent decisions in our refereeing and judging processes, there would be training associated with this role. It would likely take the form of reading/watching training material, and/or training in-person before the event.***

VIP HOSPITALITY ATTENDANT

OVERVIEW

NHRL's VIP Hospitality Attendant is responsible for checking in VIP guests, distributing exclusive merchandise, and providing additional assistance to guests as required. The VIP Hospitality Attendant role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, enjoys helping people, and likes to have a good time!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Welcome and check in VIP guests to accessible area
- Ensure entry to VIP area is for credentialed guests only
- Monitor cleanliness of the VIP area and tidy seating areas needed
- Restock VIP guest beverages and snacks throughout the event
- Coordinate with VIP guests on event tour times and processes
- Act as a point of contact for all VIP guests and assist with questions guests may have

WORKSHOP SUPERVISOR

OVERVIEW

NHRL's Workshop Supervisor is responsible for assisting competitors with repair work in the NHRL workshop by overseeing safe and proper use of tools. The Workshop Supervisor role requires an individual with an outgoing personality, applicable knowledge of various tools and equipment, and enjoys helping people!

DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES

- Oversee competitor usage of NHRL tools and equipment
- Advise competitors on proper and safe usage of tools and equipment
- Maintain facility equipment and perform regular usage-based repairs and replacements
- Assist competitors with the use of specialized tools, such as welding equipment
- Ensure NHRL tools and equipment are not damaged or stolen from the workshop
